BLITZ Changes for 2025

Effective on Tuesday, 14th of January

EVERYONE MUST READ BELOW AND FOLLOW THESE NEW REQUIREMENTS

The changes being implemented are to:

- remove issues with players hitting from different tee from what they chose as their default tee.
- remove the index restrictions so that all players paying \$10 entry can win money in all games
- level the competition in CTFSs and Skins, which will result in more payouts to more players.

Here is a summary of the changes. You may read more details at the bottom of this letter as to why these changes are being implemented.

- 1. TEE BOX SELECTION WILL REMAIN THE SAME FOR 6 MONTHS
 - a. Only twice a year (January & July by 15th) can players change their default tee box.
 - b. GOLD/COMBO TEE RESTRICTIONS
 - i. No restriction for Gold and/or Combo tees.
- 2. CTFS's TWO WINNERS ON EACH PAR 3 WHITE & COMBO Tee and GOLD Tee (\$20 winner)
 - a. CTF markers will have 2 columns to write Name & Distance (see sample at bottom)
 - b. The WHITE/COMBO tee column is only for players hitting from White/Combo tees all 18 holes.
 - c. The GOLD tee column is only for players hitting from Gold tees all 18 holes.
 - i. Combo players hitting on White tee #9 & #14 write their name in White/Combo column, DO NOT write name in GOLD TEE players column.
- 3. CANADIAN SKINs GAME \$200 pot (replaces Gross \$100 & Net \$100 skins games)
 - a. Combining both Gross & Net winners removes double payouts and equalizes the skin payouts for all players, from all tee boxes, regardless of index
 - b. In Canadian skins a low net score on a hole still wins a skin, unless a single low gross score ties the low net scores
 - i. Exp1: #9 par 3 Dec 31st Stermon Hole-in-One (gross/net 1) wins a skin even though Hoyt made birdie 2 with a stroke (also net 1).
 - ii. Exp2: #18 par 5 Eagle from fairway no stroke (gross/net 3) wins a skin even if a player(s) made birdie 4 with a stroke (also net 3)

Here is more information as to why these changes are being implemented.

1) TEE BOX SELECTION WILL REMAIN THE SAME FOR 6 MONTHS

- a) Only twice a year (January and July by 15th) can players change their default tee box.
- b) No Gold and/or Combo tee Restrictions.
- c) Also, at the discretion of the Blitz Director, long ball hitters (eligible to play Gold) that could endanger players near the green on short holes like #2 & #3 will not be allowed to play the Gold tee box
- d) This will reduce human error in Golf Genius because Default Tee Box assignments will be updated only twice a year. On the weekly tee sheet GG will automatically update all players to their Default Tee box without any manual changes by the Blitz director for a player asking to play different tee.
- e) Removes confusion to the players who get their tee box moved back and forth due to their GHIN index changing weekly above, or below, the old index restrictions.
- f) All players will know their tee box to play every week because it will stay the same for 6 months.
- g) Players can play any tee box they wish, no index restrictions limiting the games they play.
- h) Recent Pace of Play is proving tee box selection a non-issue with everyone playing ready golf, so players should be allowed to play their tee box of choice
- i) This removes players taking advantage of weekly tee box changes and getting extra strokes for Blitz game formats that use only 9 holes

2) CTF's TWO WINNERS ON EACH PAR 3 – WHITE/COMBO Tee and GOLD Tees (\$20 winner)

- a) Now that tape measures are being used the CTFS markers can have 2 winners on each par 3, separated by the tee boxes being played (White/Combo or Gold)
- b) Levels the competition between players by the tee box and removes player index restrictions
- c) Payouts will change to \$20 each for 8 winners (was \$25 each for 4 winners)
- d) CTFS markers will have 2 columns to write Name & Distance (see sample at bottom)
 - i) the WHITE/COMBO tee column is only for players hitting from White/Combo tees all 18 holes
 - ii) the GOLD tee column is for players hitting from Gold all 18 holes
 - (1) Combo players hitting on White tee #9 & #14 write name in White/Combo column
 - (2) Combo players DO NOT write name in GOLD TEE players column

3) CANADIAN SKINs GAME - \$200 pot (replaces Gross & Net skins games)

- a) Needed a solution to reduce Blitz director time and human errors of having to monitor for players indexes who may, or may not, be eligible to win a skin every week.
- b) Canadian Skins research was performed on every Blitz round in 2024 from September thru December without any player index restrictions
 - i) Not a single round showed a player winning a skin that was restricted by tee box index limit
 - ii) This showed that it was wasted time on Blitz director to monitor every week
 - iii) Even if a couple of index limited players had won a skin during the year, it would be better to pay them the small winnings vs the time and potential human error on the Blitz director
- c) Combining both Gross & Net winners removes double payouts and equalizes the skin payouts for all players, from all tee boxes, regardless of index
- d) Canadian Skins are a Net and Gross skin tournament where if multiple players tie for the lowest net score on a hole, but if only one of those players did it with their gross score, then the gross score player wins the skin.

Examples of Canadian skins where a gross score beats a net score:

- * #9 par 3 the player with a GROSS Hole-in 1 (Bob Stermon) would win a skin over the players who make a birdie 2 with a stroke for a NET 1
- * #18 par 5 the player with a GROSS Eagle 3 would win a skin over the players who makes a birdie 4 with a stroke for a NET 3
- * #8 par 4 the player with a GROSS Birdie 3 (Pat W.) would win a skin over the players who make a par 4 with a stroke for a NET 3

The board will monitor these changes over the next 6 months, or thru 2025, and reevaluate if any changes are needed.
